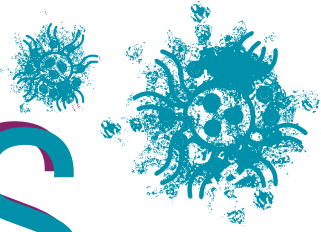

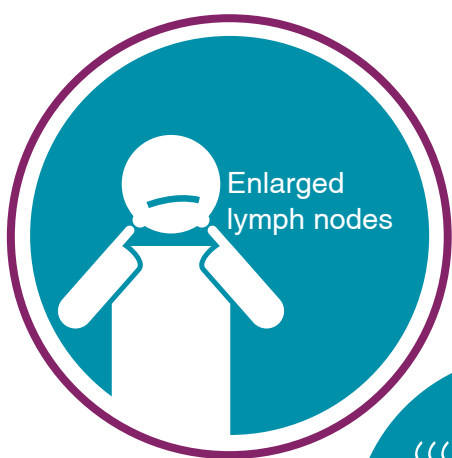


Lymphoma is cancer of the lymphocytes, or white blood cells

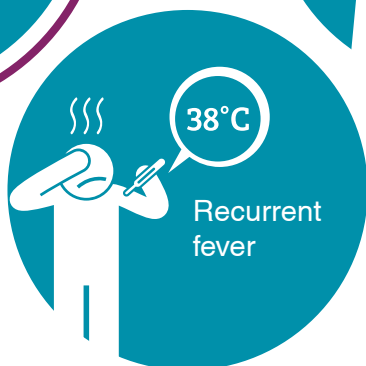
Signs and Symptoms



Enlarged lymph nodes



Itching

Breathlessness and coughing



Night Sweats

- Painless swelling in the lymph nodes
- Enlarged tonsils
- Chills or temperature swings
- Recurrent fever
- Excessive sweating
- Unexplained weight loss

- Loss of appetite
- Tiredness or general fatigue
- Breathlessness and coughing
- Persistent itch
- Headache

Why do I need to know?

There are **NO SCREENING TESTS** for lymphoma

Lymphoma symptoms can be similar to other illnesses like the flu or Covid-19.

With some lymphoma subtypes, an early diagnosis can improve patients' outcomes.
